prize steelhead and trout. Paulina Lake and East Lake, which are only 13 miles from the resort, offer great fishing and boating. Hike, bike, or horseback ride the many trails of the Paulina Range and Deschutes National Forest.

Bring your golf clubs because you can play at more than 20 golf courses in the area. The resort is 22 miles south of Bend, 50 miles to the town of Sisters (a must see experience) and 28 miles from Mount Bachelor Ski Resort with its sightseeing chairlift ride to the summit.
